**Rockwall Technology Park Welcomes
North American Composites Company**

February 20, 2008 (Rockwall, TX) – The Rockwall Economic Development Corporation (REDC) is pleased to announce that North American Composites Company (NAC), a corporation headquartered in St. Paul, Minnesota, will build a new 26,500 square foot distribution facility in the Rockwall Technology Park. NAC is a national distributor of fiberglass, resin, and related products to the composites industry. Construction is expected to begin in late Spring 2008.

“The REDC Board of Directors thanks NAC for selecting the Rockwall Technology Park for a new distribution facility. With this new building, the Park has attracted over \$60 million in new investment to Rockwall,” said Dr. Gene Burton, Chairman of the Rockwall Economic Development Corporation Board of Directors.

The \$2,200,000 project will be located at the intersection of Observation Trail and Technology Way on a 3.634-acre site. This project represents a significant expansion of the company’s distribution capabilities in the Dallas-Fort Worth area.

“We are looking forward to expanding our DFW operations with our new building in the Rockwall Technology Park. The Board and staff of the REDC made our decision easy. This new facility will play an important role in the continuing success of our company,” said Mark J. Brost, Vice President & General Manager, North American Composites Company.

The first phase of the 275-acre Rockwall Technology Park opened in 2000. This premier business park is located at State Highway 276 and FM 549 just south of Interstate Highway 30. The Park now includes ten businesses occupying over 678,000 square feet. Shovel-ready sites are now available from 3 to 22 acres.
